EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023

For the first time in Poland!

EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023 is the eighth edition of the biennial EuroSkills Competition – the **biggest vocational education and skills excellence event in Europe**.

Held every two years and **organised by WorldSkills Europe together with 32 Member Countries**, EuroSkills Competitions bring together hundreds of young professionals under the age of 25 to compete for the chance to become the **Best in Europe** in their chosen skill.

The honour and challenge of hosting EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023 was awarded to Poland just one year before the Competition would be scheduled to take place. Despite such a short preparation period, we are incredibly proud to organise the Competition.

EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023 will take place from **5 to 9 September 2023** at **AmberExpo Gdańsk and Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk**.

The event will welcome **600 skilled young professionals** under the age of 25 from 32 countries to participate in **competitions in 43 different skills** and trades. Around **100,000 visitors** from across Poland and abroad are expected to attend.

Visitors to the **free-admission** Competition will be able to watch the Competitors in action and have the opportunity to try hands-on job-related skills at the many **'Try-a-Skill' demonstrations**. The tens of thousands of school-aged young people who visit will be encouraged to turn their passions into a profession.

EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023 is organised in partnership by Poland's **Foundation For The Development Of The Education System (FRSE)**, **WorldSkills Poland**, **WorldSkills Europe**, the **City of Gdańsk** and **AmberExpo Gdańsk**.



General information



When and where?

EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023 will take place between **5-9 September 2023**. The Competition will take place at the **AMBEREXPO Exhibition and Congress Center** and in the area beside it. The Opening and Closing Ceremonies will take place at the **Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk**.

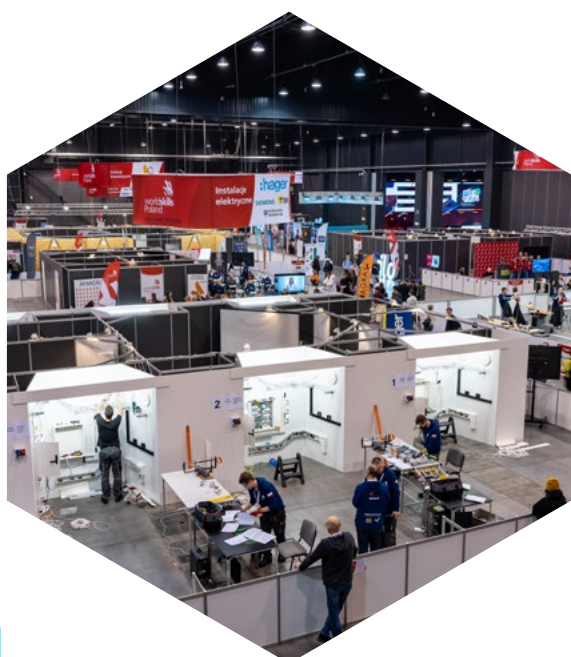
Who?

We expect to welcome **600 skilled young professionals** from **32 WorldSkills Europe Member Countries** to the event to participate in skill competitions in more than **40 different skills**. Accompanying the Competitors will be **500+ Experts** from industry and education from across Europe, together with Member Country delegations, volunteers, supporters, media, and an expected **100,000 visitors**.



Our goals:

- To **promote** technical and vocational education and training (TVET) across Europe
- To **showcase** world-class excellence in skills,
- To **provide** leaders in industry, government, and education with the opportunity to exchange information and best practices on professional education,
- To **inspire** young people about the many exciting career opportunities that TVET and skills development can lead to.



Visa Information

Poland is a part of the Schengen area and citizens of the countries belonging to the Schengen area are not required to obtain a visa to enter Poland for tourism or business purposes.

If you are not an EU citizen and plan to travel to Poland you must have a valid passport and visa. You must apply for a visa at a Polish consulate or embassy in your home country. As part of your visa application, you will need to present an invitation letter from WorldSkills Poland regarding your attendance at EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023. Transportation

Air Transportation

In Gdańsk, there is Lech Walesa Airport, serving 10 airlines. With such a well-developed air network, it is possible to

travel quickly to some of Europe's major cities, including Copenhagen, Barcelona, Munich, and Amsterdam. Transportation from the airport to the city center takes between 20 and 40 minutes, and travelers can choose from cabs, buses, trains, and car rentals.

Railway transportation

Gdańsk is very well connected with other Polish cities, thanks to its numerous and frequent train services. You can travel from Gdańsk to Warsaw in just under 3 hours, and to Krakow in just over 5 hours. In addition, from Gdańsk Station passengers can travel by Fast Urban Rail, which connects the entire Tricity (Gdańsk – Sopot – Gdynia – Wejherowo).

Getting around the city

Travellers can take advantage of a well-developed network of public transportation: buses and streetcars. Those who prefer cycling can take advantage of the city's bicycle rentals and plan their route using the network of bicycle paths, which cover a total distance of 295 km.

Media Code of Conduct

WorldSkills Europe outwardly encourages and promotes all aspects of the EuroSkills event, especially Competition press and media coverage. The following Media Code of Conduct outlines the expected behaviour from members of the media who have been accredited by WorldSkills Europe and allowed to operate on-site just before, during and just after a EuroSkills event.

For the purpose of this Media Code of Conduct – media includes reporters, journalists, photographers, and film crews.

- All media attending the EuroSkills Competition need to be accredited and ensure that their media accreditation badge/lanyard is visible at all times. All media are also subject to the WorldSkills Europe Code of Ethics and Conduct and the Competition Rules. In particular, section B.12 “Issue and Dispute Resolution” and section B.10 “Filming and Photographing at the Competition. Code of Conduct – Competitor access and Workshop Access”.
- No photographing or filming of a Competitor should take place that may be deemed to interfere with or hinder the performance of the Competitor in the Competition, (i.e. standing or positioning filming, photography, recording equipment too close – less than 1 metre – from the Competitor).
- Media may take photos and film from outside the workshop (competition area) without any prior approval. Even here, accreditation badges must be visible at all times. If any member of the media is considered to be acting inappropriately or suspiciously, they may be asked by an Expert or member of the WorldSkills Europe Secretariat to refrain from their activity and move away from the area. On request, media are obliged to comply fully with questions and requests from the Experts or WorldSkills Europe Secretariat.



- No media can enter a workshop during the Competition without receiving prior approval from the Chief Expert / Deputy Chief Expert for each skill competition. If permission is granted, any filming, photography, or interview that takes place inside a workshop (competition area) must take place from pre-agreed positions that the Chief Expert / Deputy Chief Expert says is acceptable and for a duration of time that they stipulate. Failure to comply to the Chief Expert's wishes will mean that media will be instructed to leave the workshop immediately.
- No media can enter a workshop (competition area) during breaks in the Competition without obtaining the explicit permission of the Chief Expert for that skill competition. As above, specific 'shots' or 'angles' are to be organised in discussion with the Chief Expert of the skill competition, the compatriot Expert, and the Competitor.
- No media can communicate with a Competitor without the explicit permission of the Chief Expert for that skill competition and the compatriot Expert.
- No media are to enter the 'personal work space' of a Competitor (i.e. for 'close-up' photography/filming) without the explicit permission of the Chief Expert for that skill competition and the compatriot Expert.

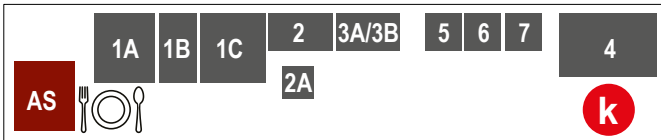
Competitor access outside the workshop (competition area)

Any media interviews with Competitors must be organised and approved via the relevant Member Country's Team Leader and the appointed Communications Officer representing the Member Country organisation (e.g. WorldSkills Belgium).

There is a zero tolerance rule against non-compliance to the Media Code of Conduct; failure to comply is likely to result in the media accreditation being removed and revoked.

Welcome to Poland!

Poland is a place that welcomes **investment, development, and innovation**, all of which are impossible to achieve without skills. The country has one of the most diverse economies in Europe, which is why it can attract investors, especially in sectors such as **IT, automotive, aerospace, food processing, cosmetics, electronics, and finance**. The Polish business environment supports start-ups and entrepreneurs, as well as nurturing research and development activities.

For centuries, Poland was a place of cross-fertilisation of nations, cultures, religions, and customs, which greatly impacted the Polish identity. Some of Poland's regions have preserved and continue to cultivate their unique costumes, language, music, dance, customs and delicious cuisine. Examples of such regions include Kashubia and Kociewie, two areas which surround our host city for the EuroSkills Competition 2023 – Gdańsk.

Pomerania is the northernmost Voivodeship (province) of Poland. The region's economic potential is based on traditional industries such as **shipbuilding, refinery, food, machinery, and furniture making**. Advanced technology industries such as IT, electronics, and biotechnology are also developing rapidly in the region. Pomerania's biggest industry is shipbuilding, bringing together production shipyards, repair facilities, and many companies which do business with the shipyards.



City of Gdańsk

Gdańsk is the largest city in northern Poland (population of 470,621) and one of the most beautiful seaside cities in Europe. It is a major Polish **seaport, a centre for inhabitants, and a vibrant metropolitan area**. It is over a thousand years old and is the capital of the Pomeranian Voivodeship. It is a city with an unusual history, wonderful monuments, and beaches, but it is also the modern business centre of the region, whose domain, apart from traditional economic sectors, includes high tech industry, renewable energy, logistics, and the chemical industry.

Gdańsk impresses with its old Main Town, modern museums and theatres, the historic Granary Island and the Gdańsk Shipyard, restaurants serving local dishes, the green coastal strip with beaches, and a promenade. It is also the third largest port of the Baltic Sea.

More than 2,500 business meetings take place in Gdańsk and Pomerania every year. With more than 50 participants on average per event, the total number of attendees exceeded 700,000 people. The city also boasts many unique venues such as the Gdańsk Shakespeare Theatre, with its retractable roof system, the Museum of the Second World War, with its distinctive 40-metre-tall leaning tower with a glass façade, and of course the Stadium – Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk – which looks like a gigantic bead of amber.

Tri-City

When we talk about **Gdańsk**, we cannot forget the city of **Sopot**, the most popular health resort in the region, and **Gdynia**, Poland's second largest port city. The three cities have, for decades, operated as a single urban organism under the name "**Tri-City**". The metropolis is also the heart of the country's coastal tourism and is visited by 7.6 million tourists every year. The excellent road, air, and railway infrastructure also make the Tri-City an attractive location for large conferences and events.





AMBEREXPO

Exhibition and Congress Center

AMBEREXPO Exhibition and Congress Center is a multifunctional space in the Tri-City Metropolitan Area owned and operated by the Gdańsk International Fair. AMBEREXPO is one of Poland's most state-of-the-art trade fairs and convention venues. It is located in the Letnica district of Gdańsk, near the Gdańsk Polsat Plus Arena, known also as the Letnica football stadium.

AMBEREXPO Exhibition and Congress Center will host the biggest ever educational event in Poland – EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023.
